## **Advisory Committee**

## Mission

• The mission of the Advisory Committee is to assist the Board of Directors and the members of the Association by offering advice, counsel and assistance from their knowledge of the Association and the field of firearms and tool mark identification.

## **Organization**

The Advisory Committee shall consist of the five (5) most immediate Past Presidents who are willing to serve; the most immediate Past President shall be the Chairman.

## **Duties/Responsibilities**

- Receive and process applications for Emeritus Member status in the manner described in the bylaws.
- Assist the Board of Directors in implementing the objectives of the Association by offering advice and counsel.
- Performing those duties that may from time to time be assigned them by the President or the Board of Directors.
- Reviewing applications for Provisional members who wish to upgrade to Regular membership, but who have no available members to write recommendations.
- The committee will review the work product of the applicant and offer letters of recommendation on their behalf, as necessary, to afford the applicant the opportunity of continued membership in the association.
