Bylaws Committee

Mission

• To receive recommended changes or modifications to the existing By-Laws and present them to the general membership for consideration.

Duties/Responsibilities

- The committee will determine which applicable Article of the By-Laws will be affected by the proposal.
- The committee members will independently evaluate the suggested changes and will offer their opinions and insight regarding the modifications.
- The committee will then be responsible for final wording of suggested changes and present them to the general membership along with a recommendation for adoption or rejection.
- Any member of the association in good standing may suggest a modification or change to the By-Laws but must do so in writing. The committee can ignore no suggested change or modification to the By-Laws.

Formalized changes to the AFTE Bylaws requires a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all Regular Members present and voting at the annual business meeting.
